




- Addresses Housing, Homeless, and Community Development Needs across the City

Funding Approval Process



- November: Council approved 2-YR Funding Priorities
- December: Neighborhood and Community Service (NCS) and Tacoma Redevelopment Authority (TCRA) release separate Notices of Funding Availability (NOFA)
- January: NCS and TCRA NOFAs close
- February: Application review / rating / presentation process conducted by TCRA Board, Human Services Commission (HSC) and ESG Panel
- April: CEDD and NCS Staff presented funding recommendations to City Council during Study Session.




