ITEM/ISSUE PROPOSED FOR COUNCIL CONSIDERATION:

I ask for your support for the inclusion of the following item on the agenda at the earliest available meeting of the Study Session:

BRIEF BACKGROUND:

When a Special Event produced by our community partners to promote their Neighborhood Business District requires a street closure, the City issued Special Event Permit dictates the number of traffic control devices required via an approved Traffic Control Plan. The event producers are responsible for acquiring barriers and the associated costs, which range from \$2,000-6,000 per event.

At the May 16, 2018 Cross District Association meeting, a memorandum prepared by City staff was shared about a potential pilot program through the first quarter of 2019 to reimburse the Neighborhood Business Districts, administered by the Cross District Association, for costs associated with traffic control devices. The costs would cover up to \$2,000 per event, for the following events:

- Art on the Ave 6th Avenue, July
- Proctor Arts Fest, Proctor District, August
- South Tacoma Car Show, South Tacoma Way, August
- Hilltop Street Fair, MLK Jr. Way, August
- Lincoln District Lunar New Year Festival, February
