Briefing Items

1. <u>18-0363</u>

Title 2.21 Housing Code Requirements for Temporary Shelters [Sue Coffman, Building Official, Planning and Development Services]

At approximately 4:32 p.m., Sue Coffman, Building Official, Planning and Development Services (PDS), made opening remarks and introduced Chris Seaman, Senior Engineer, Tacoma Fire Department, and Lauren Flemister, Senior Planner, PDS.

Council Member McCarthy arrived here, at 4:35 p.m.

Ms. Flemister reviewed the applicable codes including land use and building codes. Ms. Coffman further reviewed the building codes, including what they cover, what is considered a residential occupancy, and restrictions and requirements. She continued on the Revised Code of Washington and Washington Administrative Code provisions and limitations, stakeholder input, benchmarking involved and comparisons to other jurisdictions. She provided information on the new proposed Chapter 2.21 of Tacoma Municipal Code; including administrative provisions, operational requirements, life safety provisions, and human health provisions. She concluded by reviewing next steps.

Discussion ensued regarding internal stakeholders and potential partners, the exemption of single use tents in the code, non-building proposals, land use inspections, building schedules, expiration and extension of permits, change of occupancy applications, building permit applications, requirements for residential occupancy, emergency situations, and the exemption from State Code requirements.

MOTION: Deputy Mayor Ibsen moved to recommend the new, proposed Chapter 2.21 of the Municipal Code, relating to Housing Code Requirements for Temporary Shelters, to the full City Council for consideration.
