

## **RESOLUTION NO. 40035**

A RESOLUTION relating to maintenance of permeable roadways; authorizing the execution of an agreement with Pierce County, in the amount of \$10,000, for a one-year term, with an automatic renewal for four additional one-year terms, for an aggregate contract total of \$50,000, budgeted from the Surface Water Fund, to assist in the enhanced maintenance of the City's permeable pavement.

WHEREAS the Environmental Services Department ("ES"), in partnership with the Public Works Department, began installing permeable roadways over five years ago to support healthy neighborhoods and a thriving Puget Sound, as well as supporting the City's Environmental Action Plan and GreenRoads Policy, and

WHEREAS these permeable roadways, just like traditional roadways, are swept twice a year by the City's regenerative air sweepers, and some of permeable roadways are starting to see isolated areas that are clogging beyond the capacity of the City's sweepers, and

WHEREAS, currently, the City does not have enough areas needing enhanced maintenance to utilize specialized equipment for more than a few weeks each year; additionally, the technology for permeable pavement maintenance is evolving at a rapid pace, and

WHEREAS Pierce County has enhanced street sweepers that can restore these clogged areas, and the City desires to contract Pierce County Planning and Public Works, Maintenance and Operations Division, for these services, and

WHEREAS ES staff is recommending approval of the proposed contract with Pierce County, in the amount of \$10,000 for a one-year year term, with an automatic renewal for four additional one-year terms, for an aggregate contract

WHEREAS the proposed contract is a cost-effective solution for current needs, and will allow the City to evaluate the technology as it evolves; Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Pierce County, in the amount of \$10,000 for a one-year term, with an automatic renewal for four additional one-year terms, for an aggregate contract total of \$50,000, budgeted from the Surface Water Fund, to assist in the enhanced maintenance of the City's permeable pavement, said contract to be substantially in the form of the document on file in the office of the City Clerk.
