Briefing Items

3. 18-0571 Tacoma Mall Update and Trends in the National Retail Activities
[Pat Beard, Project Manager, Community and Economic Development Department - Private Capital Division]

At approximately 10:04 a.m., Pat Beard, Project Manager, Community and Economic Development, made opening remarks and introduced Chuck Davis, Senior Vice President of Development, West Stanford Shopping Center, and Cara Ritchie, General Manager, Tacoma Mall. Mr. Davis provided background information on Simon Malls, including the number of centers throughout the country, occupancy rates, stock trends, history behind the business, operations, business models, consumer trends, and online business trends. He continued on the redevelopment concept of the Tacoma Mall, including department size reductions, consumer desire, location of the proposal, features, design firm involved, design logic, site property lineup, street tree enhancements, proposed tenants and retailers, expansions of current tenants, architecture, and letter of intents initiated.

Discussion ensued throughout regarding the proposed site plan, including the location of the proposed theater addition, permitting process and timeline, barriers, potential for appeals, and walkability. Discussion continued on community and external concern and support, brick and mortar evolvement, a retail scoping study including private property owners and outreach and opportunities. Discussion concluded on what involvement the City Council can have in the progression of the redevelopment.
