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
GENERAL FUND FORECAST - STRUCTURAL GAP

 Ongoing General Fund expenditures are growing at a faster rate than revenues


Average % Growth from 2020-2024











HISTORIC FIRE ELECTRICAL MAINT. BLDG: EXTERIOR REFURBISHMENT

BIENNIAL BUDGET

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BONDING

City Council Approved Authority (LTGO)

- Bond capacity limit of \$81 M
- Debt service: \$1 M annually for approximately \$12 M in Bonds
- Funded through existing revenues
- Policy decision on what percentage of General Fund supports debt

Voter Approved Authority (UTGO)

- Bond capacity limit of over \$336 million
- Debt service: same as LTGO
- Funded through increased property tax above levy limit
- Requires 60% voter approval

Public Safety- EMS	Ambulance Fees	Council Action	Depends on Implementation
Streets	Local Option Motor Vehicle Fuel Tax	County Council and Public Vote	Up to \$1-3 M
· Streets	Vehicle Fees	Transportation Benefit Districts (TBD) and Voters	\$6 M
Multiple Uses	Impact Fees	City Council or Transportation Benefit District (TBD)	Depends on Implementation
Multiple Uses	Fees: Permitting, Fire, Inspections, Public Works	City Council	Depends on Implementation

All Potential Uses	Admission Tax for Non-Profits	City Council	\$340 K
All Potential Uses	Business License Fees	City Council	\$1.1 M
All Potential Uses	Head Tax	City Council	Depends on Implementation

FEES

- Factors in determining fee rates
 - Cost of service
 - Demand/utilization of services
 - Benefit to individuals or community

Fire

 Considerations include the cost of service, over use of services that impact ability to respond to community calls for service

Permitting

 Costs of providing service, increases over time, individual benefit vs. community
