At approximately 4:36 p.m., Andreta Armstrong, Program Manager, Office of Equity and Human Rights, stated staff is requesting to extend the prohibitions relating to temporary protections contained in Amended Ordinance No. 28508, from September 30, 2018 to October 31, 2018. She further stated this action will allow staff enough time to continue working on the Tenant Rights Code and provided information on the legislation process, including stakeholders' feedback, draft language, timeline, and next steps.

Discussion ensued regarding clarification on staff's request and the extended date.

The Committee reached a general consensus on forwarding staff's request to the full City Council.
