

RESOLUTION NO. 40098

A RESOLUTION relating to collective bargaining; authorizing the execution of a Letter of Agreement negotiated between the City of Tacoma and Tacoma Police Union, Local 6, I.U.P.A.

WHEREAS the City has, for years, adopted the policy of collective bargaining between the various labor organizations representing employees and the administration, and

WHEREAS Resolution No. 39983, adopted April 10, 2018, authorized the execution of the 2017-2019 Collective Bargaining Agreement ("CBA") between the City of Tacoma and Tacoma Police Union, Local 6, I.U.P.A. ("Union"), on behalf of the employees represented by said Union, and

WHEREAS there are currently 332 full-time, budgeted positions within the bargaining unit, and

WHEREAS the City and Union have negotiated a Letter of Agreement ("LOA") to the CBA which provides for the following: (1) bargaining unit employees assigned to the Homicide Unit will receive an application of rate in the amount of 5%, and (2) bargaining unit employees not assigned to the Homicide Unit, who are called to investigate a homicide (or any other incident normally investigated by the Homicide Unit), will receive an application of rate in the amount of 5% for those assigned hours, and

WHEREAS it appears in the best interest of the City that the LOA negotiated by said Union and the City be approved; Now, Therefore,



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute the Letter of Agreement negotiated between the City of Tacoma and Tacoma Police Union, Local 6, I.U.P.A., said document to be substantially in the form of the document on file in the office of the City Clerk.
