

## **RESOLUTION NO. 40109**

BY REQUEST OF MAYOR WOODARDS AND COUNCIL MEMBERS HUNTER AND USHKA

A RESOLUTION authorizing the use of \$10,000, budgeted from the City Council Contingency Fund, for sponsorship of the 2019 Interfaith Women's Conference scheduled for March 15-16, 2019.

WHEREAS the Interfaith Women's Conference began in 2017 as a biennial conference hosted by Associated Ministries to bring women together to experience the power of unity and to strengthen the community, and

WHEREAS the conference provides women with a forum to explore ways to work together to assist people in need, and conference organizers are dedicated to engaging all women, and

WHEREAS the conference achieves its objectives through a variety of sessions over the course of the event, and

WHEREAS the conference will feature speaker Elizabeth Smart, who is a survivor of child abduction; through her story, Ms. Smart shares what it takes to overcome trauma and encourages those who have gone through similar experiences to find the strength needed to reclaim one's life, and

WHEREAS Ms. Smart has also used her traumatic experience to advocate for changes needed in child abduction, recovery programs, and national legislation, and also helped promote The National AMBER Alert, The Adam Walsh Child Protection & Safety Act, and other safety legislation to help prevent abductions, and



WHEREAS conference organizers are working with the Crystal Judson Family Justice Center and the YWCA to distribute free tickets, supported by event funding, to a number of domestic violence survivors to attend and briefly meet with Ms. Smart following her presentation, and

WHEREAS, at the September 11, 2018, Study Session, Mayor Woodards shared a Council Consideration Request to authorize the one-time use of \$10,000 from the City Council Contingency Fund for sponsorship of the conference, and

WHEREAS the requested \$10,000 in funding will provide the following benefits to the City: strengthen connections between diverse groups, increase the ability of residents throughout the City to engage in public service, and provide a healing resource to those who have been impacted by trauma so that they may rise to their full potential, and

WHEREAS RCW 35.33.145 and 35.34.250 authorize a withdrawal from the City Council Contingency fund for any municipal expense, the necessity or extent of which could not have been foreseen or reasonably evaluated at the time of adopting the budget, and

WHEREAS the need for sponsorship of the 2019 Interfaith Women's Conference could not have been foreseen or reasonably evaluated at the time the City adopted its biennial budget, and

WHEREAS Ordinance No. 22569 requires an affirmative vote of not less than six members of the Council in order to withdraw moneys from this fund; Now, Therefore,
