Briefing Items

4. <u>18-1310</u> Citizen Police Advisory Committee Interviews [Doris Sorum, City Clerk]

At approximately 4:33 p.m., the Committee interviewed Louis Cooper, Kiara Daniels, Stephen Hagberg, and Fredrick Powell.

Discussion ensued regarding candidates' qualifications, Committee vacancies, and applicants not in attendance.

MOTION: Council Member Thoms moved to recommend the reappointment of Louis Cooper to the "At-Large No. 5" position of the Citizen Police Advisory Committee to serve a three-year term, effective January 1, 2019, to expire December 31, 2021.

ACTION: Voice vote was taken and carried. The motion was declared adopted.

Discussion ensued regarding rescheduling interviews for the applicants not in attendance, the timeline of appointing applicants to the Committee, and term end dates.

At approximately 5:18 p.m., Andreta Armstrong, Manager, Office of Equity and Human Rights, made opening remarks and introduced Jen Haggard, Commissioner, Human Rights Commission. Ms. Haggard presented on gender neutral labeling of single-occupancy restrooms, including why Pride at Work decided to focus on this topic, background, and requested for an ordinance to amend the Tacoma Municipal Code Chapter 1.29 relating to the Human Rights Commission, to add a new section. She further provided an ordinance that put a similar code in place in the City of Bainbridge Island, draft language for an ordinance, letters of support, and statements from community members.

Discussion ensued regarding the labeling of single-occupancy restrooms,

locations that currently have gender neutral bathrooms, if locations can voluntarily have gender neutral bathrooms and still meet Code requirements, current Code requirements, the need to review current ordinances to identify inadvertent hardships caused by technicalities, if the request is only for newly established businesses, and additional language to consider for the ordinance.

MOTION: Council Member Hunter moved to recommend the gender-neutral labeling of single-occupancy restrooms to the full City Council for consideration.

SECONDED BY: Council Member Thoms.

ACTION: Voice vote was taken and carried. The motion was declared adopted.
