

RESOLUTION NO. 40205

A RESOLUTION relating to the multi-family property tax exemption program; authorizing the execution of a Multi-Family Housing Eight-Year Limited Property Tax Exemption Agreement with Glasshouse Two, LLC for the development of 131 multi-family market-rate rental housing units to be located at 308 Tacoma Avenue South in the Downtown Regional Growth Center.

WHEREAS the City has, pursuant to chapter 84.14 of the Revised Code of Washington, designated several Residential Target Areas for the allowance of a limited property tax exemption for new multi-family residential housing, and

WHEREAS the City has, through Ordinance No. 25789, enacted a program whereby property owners in Residential Target Areas may qualify for a Final Certificate of Tax Exemption which certifies to the Pierce County

Assessor-Treasurer that the owner is eligible to receive a limited property tax exemption, and

WHEREAS Glasshouse Two, LLC, is proposing to develop 131 market-rate rental units to consist of 33 studio units, with an average size of 390 square feet and renting for approximately \$1,400 per month; 82 one-bedroom, one-bath units with an average size of 450 square feet and renting for approximately \$1,700 per month; and 16 two-bedroom, two bath units with an average size of 760 square feet and renting for approximately \$2,100 per month, as well as 66 on-site residential parking stalls, and

WHEREAS the Director of Community and Economic Development has reviewed the proposed property tax exemption and recommends that a conditional property tax exemption be awarded for the property located at 308 Tacoma Avenue



South in the Downtown Regional Growth Center, as more particularly described in the attached Exhibit "A"; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That the City Council does hereby approve and authorize a conditional property tax exemption, for a period of eight years, to Glasshouse Two, LLC, for the property located at 308 Tacoma Avenue South in the Downtown Regional Growth Center, as more particularly described in the attached Exhibit "A."

Section 2. That the proper officers of the City are authorized to execute a Multi-Family Housing Eight-Year Limited Property Tax Exemption Agreement with Glasshouse Two, LLC, said document to be substantially in the form of the proposed agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk.
