Subject:	Financial Impact of 483 Water Pollution Wage Increase

Overview

A Tentative Agreement between the City of Tacoma and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 483 Water Pollution Unit, has been reached for a successor collective bargaining agreement for the year 2018-2019.

Financial Impact

Effective January 1, 2018, all classifications shall receive an across the board wage increase of 2.5%.

Effective January 1, 2019, all classifications shall receive an across the board wage increase of 3.0%

Effective January 1, 2019, the safety footwear allowance shall increase from \$250.00 to \$300.00 annually.
