Items of Mutual Interest and Shared Concerns Related to Homelessness, Potential Business Developments and Land Use Projects

At approximately 2:36 p.m., Mayor Woodards provided opening remarks and noted the Tideflats Subarea Plan intergovernmental agreement (IGA), which includes the Puyallup Tribe of Nations (Tribe), was recently approved by all parties. Puyallup Tribal Council Chair Bill Sterud provided opening remarks and introduced Tribal Council Members Annette Bryan, Tim Reynon, and James Rideout.

Discussion ensued regarding coordination and partnerships between the City and Tribe; issues and efforts related to homelessness, housing affordability, and rental housing; City and Tribal services and community programs; the Tideflats Subarea Plan and process; the proposed liquefied natural gas (LNG) plant on the Tideflats; impacts to the Puyallup River; and the idea to schedule regular meetings between the City and Tribal Council.

Mayor Woodards concluded by thanking the Tribal Council members and stated the regular study session would resume at the close of the special joint meeting, after a brief recess.
