## \*\*\*\*RATE CHANGE



- BIA Annual Meeting held on February 28, 2019
- Board passed 2019-2020 Work Plan, Budget and Assessment rates
- For the past several years, the BIA has been drawing on reserves to balance the budget.
- The increase in rates to this year's budget will balance the budget without using reserves.
