At approximately 5:03 p.m., Reuben McKnight, Historical Preservation Officer, Planning and Development Services, made opening remarks and introduced Jennifer Keating, member, Puyallup Tribe of Indians.

Mr. McKnight presented the proposal to rename the Puyallup River Bridge as the Fishing Wars Memorial Crossing and Bridge, including background, location of the bridge, and a request for recommendation to the full City Council. Ms. Keating provided historical context of the location and its importance to the Puyallup Tribe of Indians.

Discussion ensued regarding the history of the project and the opportunity it affords for future learning.
