What can I expect after the transition?

- As billing transitions, messaging will include bill pay options:
 - In-person, Tacoma and other south sound locations
 - By mail, Online, and Auto-pay
 - Bill message will include,
 "How to read my bill" instructions



What can I expect after the transition?

- Bill will come from Rainier Connect
- We have a local office to assist customers in person and 24/7 support available by phone
- Consistent upgrades to the network, including speed upgrades and new products as they come to market

What can I expect after the transition?

- Rainier Connect currently offers residential customers cable modem speeds up to 500 mpbs, fiber speeds up to 1,000 mbps, Stream TV, and phone services
