SUMMARY:

The Infrastructure, Planning, and Sustainability Committee will consider and may recommend the reassignment of one member on the Planning Commission.

BACKGROUND:

The Planning Commission consists of nine members appointed by the City Council for three-year terms. All members must be residents of Tacoma. Commission meetings occur the first and third Wednesday of each month at 5:00 p.m.

The Planning Commission develops and updates the Comprehensive Plan and its elements; formulates effective and efficient land use and development regulations and processes that implement the Comprehensive Plan; and reviews various planning issues, such as area-wide zoning reclassifications, moratoria, interim zoning, pre-annexation planning, historic district designation, urban design, and transportation and capital facilities programs.

ISSUE:

The reassignment of a current Planning Commission Member to allow for additional expertise on public transportation.

ALTERNATIVES:

The Planning Commission Member will remain in the Public Transportation position.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff requests that the Infrastructure, Planning, and Sustainability Committee recommend the reassignment of one member on the Planning Commission, which would be forwarded to the full City Council on July 30, 2019.
