		[Jared Eyer and Tammy Liddle Lobban, Senior Management & Budget Analysts, Finance]
		At approximately 10:04 a.m., Jared Eyer and Tammy Liddle Lobban, Senior Management and Budget Analysts, Finance, introduced the topic, participatory budgeting (PB).
		Council Member Blocker arrived here, at 10:05 a.m.
		Mr. Eyer presented an overview on PB, including the background; goals; voter participation trends; recommended pilot PB process; benefits; and measurements of success, including outcome goals and process measures. Ms. Liddle Lobban reviewed the methodology, Tacoma's Equity Index, community selection, timeline, and budget. Mr. Eyer concluded by reviewing case study results, growth opportunities, and lessons learned.
		Discussion ensued throughout regarding the recommended pilot PB process, outcome goals, voter participation, inclusion of age groups in jurisdictions, budget scope, civic participation, PB performances, neighborhood council involvement, Health Department engagement, Tacoma's Equity Index, and next phase possibilities.

		At approximately 10:41 a.m., Nick Bratton, Policy Director, Forterra, presented an overview of the Forterra Asset Mapping project, including background; partners; outcomes; a mapping tool example; and next steps, including home establishment, funding, upkeep, utilization, and tool integration.
