 - Our hiring goal was 42 commissioned positions


Status of New Hires


- 48 are currently on probation in Patrol 15 are currently in Patrol Training and the remaining 33 are in the last phase and on their own in Patrol

- 7 Lateral applicants are currently going through the hiring process















Explorer Program

- Continue to recruit for our Explorer Program to target youths that may be interested in law enforcement
- Increased membership within our Department Explorer Program from 8 to twenty-five
- Tacoma Police Explorer Post has been recognized as the Post of the Year for the State of Washington by the Washington State Law Enforcement Exploring Advisors
- For the first time in the history of the Tacoma Police Explorer Program, we sent four Explorers to the National Police Explorer Competition at Purdue University
- Tacoma Police Explorer Adbulghani Nagi-Mosa (our 2018 Explorer of the Year), is one of three Police Explorers in the State of Washington who received a Washington Law Enforcement Exploring Advisors Scholarship Award
