#### Call to Order

### **Briefing Items**

1. <u>19-0689</u> Environmental Action Plan

At approximately 12:05 p.m., Jim Parvey, Environmental Services Division Manager, Office of Environmental Policy and Sustainability (OEPS), introduced Kristi Lynett, Sustainability Officer, OEPS; and presented the Environmental Action Plan (EAP), including an overview; background; and target goals and actions taken regarding natural systems. Ms. Lynett presented target goals and actions taken regarding air and local food, buildings and energy, transportation, materials management, and climate resiliency. Mr. Parvey concluded by outlining the next steps.

Discussion ensued throughout regarding developing a tree canopy in the City, how tree preservation policies intersect with code, the application for planting trees, options for waste and recycle management, creating infrastructure to support tree planting, education on recycling, metrics for city-wide greenhouse gas emissions, electrification infrastructure, and ways to encourage the use of electric vehicles.

2. <u>19-0690</u> Facilities Tour Debrief and Facilities Assessment Overview

At approximately 12:56 p.m., Katie Johnston, Budget Officer, Finance, made opening remarks and presented the capital investment strategy, including agenda, best practices, City assets, and 2019-2020 funded initiatives.

Justin Davis, Facilities Division Manager, Public Works, outlined the facility

assessment; assessment findings for multiple facilities, noting general information, observed facilities, and average facility condition index; and investment needs. Ms. Johnston concluded with next steps, discussion, and feedback.

Discussion ensued regarding observed deficiencies versus level of service, deferred maintanence versus replacement, locations of critical facilities in the City, and the maintenance needed in poorer areas.
