SUMMARY:

This informational briefing is designed to describe the organizational arrangements made to form the Transit Orientated Development Advisory Group (TODAG). The TODAG will have its first meeting on August 19, 2019.

BACKGROUND:

The TODAG was established by Resolution No. 40303. The TODAG will be supported by staff from Public Works, Planning and Development Services, and Community and Economic Development (CED) departments.

Staff have worked with the Planning Commission and Transportation Commission to identify a broad cross-section of stakeholders to be represented on the TODAG. The City Manager has sent out invitations to potential TODAG members and an organizational meeting has been scheduled for August 19, 2019. There is some time sensitivity as CED has arranged for an Urban Land Institute panel to convene in the Dome District in early September and would like to informally involve the TODAG. Depending on interest and participation more members could be added as the TODAG work program develops.
