***OVERVIEW



- Statewide paid leave now benefits Tacoma workers and state minimum wage will bypass Tacoma's minimum wage in 2020

*******BACKGROUND



- In 2015, the City Council adopted Tacoma Municipal Code (TMC) 18.20—the Minimum Wage Law, which went into effect on February 1, 2016.
- In November 2016 voters approved Washington State Initiative 1433, changing statewide employment standards.
- In January 2018, new State laws went into effect.

- Currently two agencies (L&I and City) to go to with questions and complaints.
- L&I enforcement model now includes workplace wide investigations.
