

ORDINANCE NO. 28631

AN ORDINANCE relating to property tax levies; authorizing an increase for the 2020 Emergency Medical Services property tax levy in terms of both dollars and percentage.

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 84.55.120, the City is requesting an increase in the amount collected for the 2020 Tacoma Emergency Medical Services ("EMS") property tax levy, and

WHEREAS it is necessary to identify the amount of estimated revenues from property tax levies to match the estimated expenditures for debt service and other funding requirements, and

WHEREAS the assessed values in the EMS property tax boundary have increased since 2012, with the current valuation at \$29,776,151,261.00, and

WHEREAS this ordinance will allow the EMS levy to be set at the highest allowable amount of \$11,137,435.44, which is a 0.64033 percent increase, representing a \$70,862.38 increase over the previous year's actual levy of \$11,066,573.06, and

WHEREAS the population of the district is more than 10,000; Now, Therefore,



BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TACOMA:

That the 2020 Emergency Medical Services property tax levy is hereby authorized to increase by 0.64033 percent and \$70,862.38 from the previous year's actual levy of \$11,066,573.06, exclusive of the increase due to new construction, improvements to property, newly constructed wind turbines, any annexations that have occurred and administrative refunds made, and any increases in the value of state-assessed property.
