BACKGROUND:

The Landmarks Preservation Commission oversees the establishment and regulation of landmarks, local historic districts, proposed name changes for public facilities, and certain property tax incentives. The Commission consists of 11 members comprised of three architects, four individuals with professional expertise in preservation related fields, and four interested citizens. Non-voting ex-officio members may be appointed to represent property and business owners within Tacoma's historic districts.

ISSUE:

Six positions need to be filled.

ALTERNATIVES:

The Committee would continue to operate without full membership.
