






- Update on the outcomes of the 2018-2019 Code Pilot Project over a 12 month period




POSTIVE OUTCOMES



- Closed more cases during the pilot project (241 cases)
- Cases during the pilot project are being closed faster

**** NEXT STEPS



- Continue to issue Notices of Violation to banks on abandoned/foreclosed properties they finance (HB2057)
- Adjust YARD program to provide more support to qualifying residents
- Continue to pursue receivership and/or acquisition and rehabilitation in collaboration with CED
- Continue Top 15 list in 3, 4, & 5 while waiting for equity study
- NCS will return to CVS to report progress in early Q1 2020
