Pierce Transit invites you to learn more about Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) and the project plans for this new transit service along Pacific Avenue/SR-7 between Tacoma and Spanaway. In early April, the BRT project will be about 30 percent designed.

SPECIAL PROJECT UPDATE:

In March, a Pierce Transit contractor will be conducting required soil sampling along the future Bus Rapid Transit route.

This will require about three weeks of temporary lane closures along Pacific Avenue/SR-7, working in sections from Military Road to downtown Tacoma. The contractor will not be working in the road during peak traffic times.

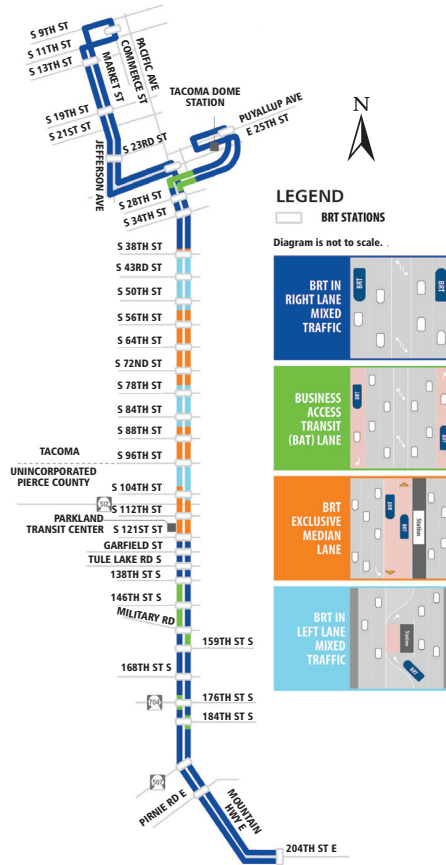
