1 A RESOLUTION relating to surplus property; declaring certain real property owned by the Department of Public Utilities, Water Division (d.b.a. "Tacoma 2 Water"), consisting of approximately 4.74 acres of property located in the Bonney Lake vicinity of unincorporated Pierce County, Washington, surplus 3 to the needs of the City; and authorizing the negotiated sale and conveyance of said property to Nash Cascadia Verde LLC for \$125,000. 4 5 WHEREAS the City of Tacoma, Department of Public Utilities, Water 6 Division (d.b.a. "Tacoma Water"), owns approximately 4.74 acres of property 7 located in the Bonney Lake vicinity of unincorporated Pierce County, Washington 8 ("Property"), with an estimated market value of \$125,000, as more fully described 9 10 in the documents on file in the office of the City Clerk, and 11 WHEREAS Tacoma Water has determined the Property is no longer 12 essential for continued effective utility service, and 13 WHEREAS Nash Cascadia Verde LLC has offered to purchase the Property 14 for \$125,000, which is deemed acceptable by Tacoma Water and the Department 15 16 of Public Works, Real Property Services Division, and 17 WHEREAS the purchase price takes into consideration the reservation of a 18 permanent easement to Tacoma Water for use as an access road for current and 19 future operations, and 20 WHEREAS the Department of Public Works proceeded with the negotiated 21 22 disposition process pursuant to Tacoma Municipal Code ("TMC") 1.06.280.F, and 23 WHEREAS, on February 26, 2020, by adoption of Public Utility Board 24 Resolution No. U-11146, the Property was declared surplus to Tacoma Water's 25 needs and approved for sale, pending confirmation from the City Council, and 26 - 1 -



1	WHEREAS, on May 5, 2020, pursuant to RCW 35.94.040 and	
2	TMC 1.06.280, the City Council conducted a public hearing on the proposed sale of	
3	said Property, and	
4 5	WHEREAS, there being no foreseeable need for continued City ownership of	
6	the Property, the sale of said Property appears to be in the best interests of the	
7	City, pending final approval from the City Council; Now, Therefore,	
8	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:	
9	Section 1. That continued ownership of approximately 4.74 acres of property	
10 11	located in the Bonney Lake vicinity of unincorporated Pierce County, Washington,	
12	owned by the City of Tacoma, through its Department of Public Utilities, Water	
13	Division, is not essential to the needs of the City and is hereby declared surplus	
14	pursuant to RCW 35.94.040, RCW 35.22.020, Article I, Section 1.2, and Article IX,	
15	Section 9.1, of the Tacoma City Charter.
