Reduced Irrigation and Water Usage in City-Maintained Parks and Fountains

DATE:

April 29, 2020

In response to the current budget situation, Public Works Street Operations is implementing measures to reduce water usage in our parks and rights-of-way landscapes. These measures are similar to what Metropolitan Parks is implementing at their parks and similar to what we have done in the past during severe droughts.

Stand-alone turf areas and seasonal flower beds will not be watered. Turf will be allowed to go dormant and will turn brown. Annual flowers will also not be planted in parks and sidewalk planters. Irrigation will be directed towards sensitive landscapes and to preserve the health of our trees. Decorative water fountains will also remain off to reduce maintenance costs and water consumption.

Additionally, Street Operations has closed facilities and parking areas in our parks to encourage social distancing.
