Subject: Fiscal Impact for the Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers and Trainmen

## **Background:**

The language in the collective bargaining agreement for the Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers and Trainmen (BLE) provides that in the event a new agreement is not reached by July 1, 2019, the basic daily rate of pay for locomotive engineers shall be increased by an amount equal to 100% of the Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers (CPI-W), Seattle area all items, measured from June of 2015 to June of 2016, with a minimum increase of two (2) percent and a maximum increase of four (4) percent.

## **Financial Impact:**

• The CPI-W increase for this period was published as two (2) percent. Since an agreement has not been reached, the ordinance will provide for an increase of two (2) percent effective July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021. There are twenty employees covered by this agreement.
