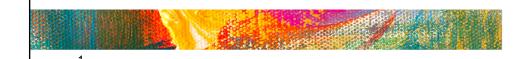

## 2020 BUDGET: \$40 M GF REDUCTIONS TARGET

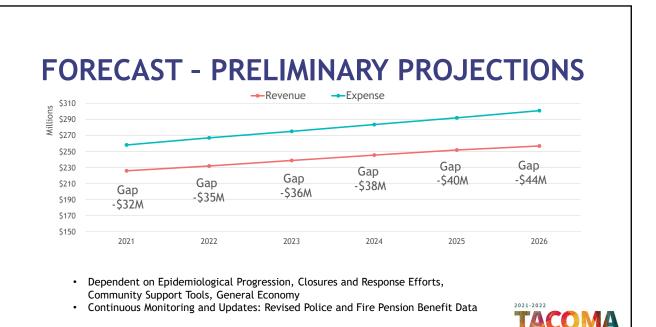
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# GENERAL FUND FORECAST 2021-2026

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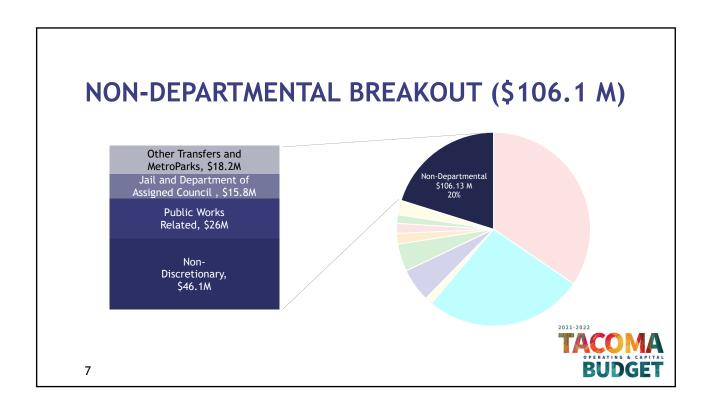


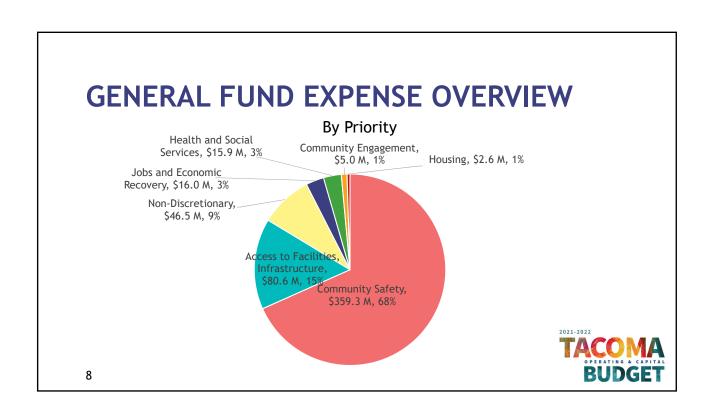

### RISK AREAS - \$67M - \$84M NOT INCLUDED IN FORECASTED EXPENSES

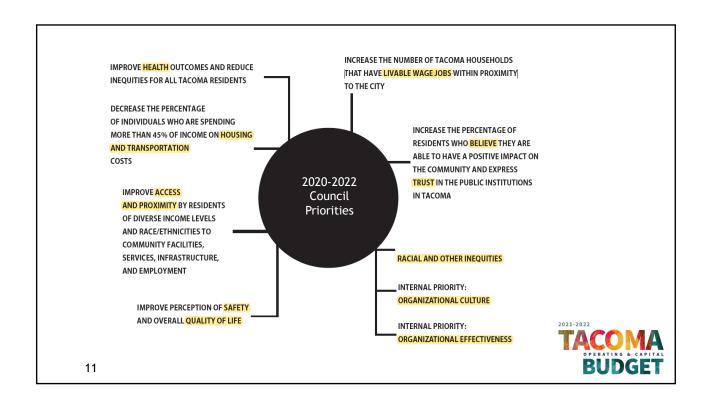

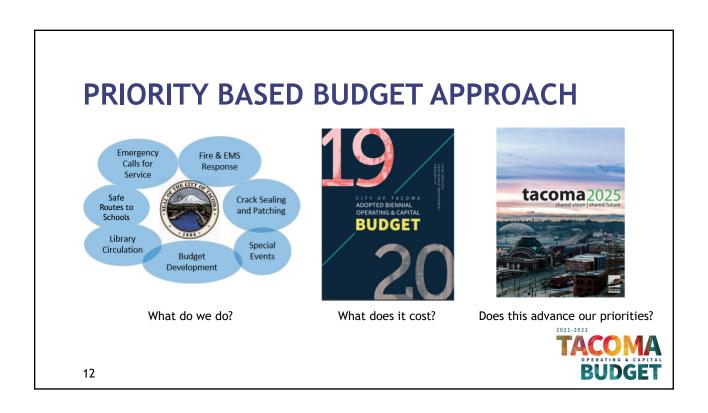

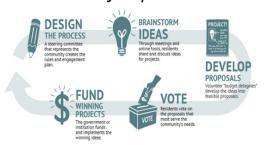
