COVID-19 TRENDS



- COVID-19 transmission is widespread in Pierce County.
- In the last 14 days, we've reported 1,257 cases.
- Our 14-day case rate per 100,000 is 139.4.
- Our average cases per day over the last 14 days is 89.8.

****RECORD CASES



- 23% of cases are among 20-29 year olds who make up 14% of our population.
- 40% of cases are among 20-39 year olds who make up 27% of our population.
- We see an increase of cases or secondary transmissions from Fourth of July and all types of gatherings in Phase 2 where people are not physical distancing and not wearing face coverings.
- More businesses are experiencing small numbers of cases, and we see clusters of cases throughout Pierce County.



*******WHAT'S NEXT?




- We need people to double down on behaviors that will help stop the spread.

- Last Thursday, Health Officer issued recommendation that Pierce County schools be remote only to start in the fall.


