## **RESOLUTION NO. 40644**

- A RESOLUTION relating to storm pond maintenance; authorizing the execution of an Interlocal Agreement with the Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife, Noxious Weed Program, in the total amount of \$300,000 over a five-year period, budgeted from the Surface Water Fund, for the treatment of nuisance weeds in the Regional Flett Stormwater Ponds located within the Mountain View Cemetery.
- 5 WHEREAS the Flett Stormwater Ponds receive runoff from over 7,000 acres 6 within the City, and act to slow down and retain runoff during storm events, 7 preventing upstream flooding, downstream erosion, and habitat degradation, and 8 WHEREAS nuisance weeds block intake screens of the Flett Creek pump 9 10 station, and removal of these aquatic plants will reduce the flood risk to the 11 Mountain View Cemetery and upstream properties; reduce risk to maintenance 12 workers who clear blocked intake screens by hand; and prevent the spread of 13 these weeds to downstream habitats, including the Flett Wetland and Flett Creek. 14 a fish-bearing tributary of Chambers Creek and a key habitat for local fisheries, 15 16 and 17 WHEREAS the Environmental Services ("ES") Department is recommending

WHEREAS the Environmental Services ("ES") Department is recommending
the execution of an interlocal agreement with the Washington State Department of
Fish and Wildlife in the maximum amount of \$60,000 per year, for a total of
\$300,000 over a five-year period, budgeted from the Surface Water Fund, for
annual aquatic plant and algae maintenance services in the Regional Flett
Stormwater Ponds located within the Mountain View Cemetery, and

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WHEREAS herbicide application will provide five years of direct control, an 1 additional four to six years post-control, will act on plant roots, and is significantly 2 lower in cost than mechanical harvesting and dredging, and 3 WHEREAS the NPDES Aquatic Plant and Algae General Permit allows 4 annual herbicide treatment of 60 percent of the surface area of the ponds, and 5 6 aerial video will be obtained prior to and six to eight weeks following treatment, and 7 WHEREAS evaluation criteria will include post-application extent of 8 nuisance plants, evidence of nuisance plants regrowth, native plant establishment, 9 and occurrence of algae blooms, and 10 WHEREAS the state Department of Fish and Wildlife is ideally suited for this 11 12 work, as the application team has intimate knowledge of sensitive aquatic species, 13 experience working in critical aquatic habitats, and a favorable relationship with the 14 state Department of Ecology, and 15 WHEREAS ES staff is recommending execution of the proposed interlocal 16 agreement with the Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife for the 17 18 purpose of establishing a maintenance contract for storm pond maintenance for 19 localized flood control; Now, Therefore, 20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA: 21 That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute an 22 Interlocal Agreement with the Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife, 23 24 Noxious Weed Program, in the amount of \$300,000 over a five-year period, 25 budgeted from the Surface Water Fund, for the treatment of nuisance weeds in the 26
