

RESOLUTION NO. 40650

A RESOLUTION relating to collective bargaining; authorizing the execution of a Letter of Agreement negotiated between the City of Tacoma and the Professional and Technical Employees Union, Local 17, regarding voluntary recognition of a classification to be titled Engineering Instrumentation Technician, Senior.

WHEREAS the City has, for years, adopted the policy of collective bargaining between the various labor organizations representing employees and the administration, and

WHEREAS Resolution No. 40493, adopted December 3, 2019, authorized the execution of the four-year Collective Bargaining Agreement ("CBA") between the City of Tacoma and the Professional and Technical Employees Union, Local 17 ("Union"), on behalf of the employees represented by said Union, and

WHEREAS the City and Union have negotiated a Letter of Agreement ("LOA") to the CBA which provides for the following: (1) the City will voluntarily recognize the Union as the collective bargaining representative of the Engineering Instrumentation Technician, Senior classification; and (2) establish rates of pay for the classification, which will be designated as hourly and eligible for overtime pay, and

WHEREAS the LOA was considered and approved by the Public Utility
Board at its special meeting of August 26, 2020, and

WHEREAS it appears in the best interest of the City that the LOA negotiated between said Union and the City be approved; Now, Therefore,



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

That the proper officers of the	ne City are hereby authorized to execute the
Letter of Agreement negotiated be	tween the City of Tacoma and Professional and
Technical Employees Union, Local	17, said document to be substantially in the form
of the document on file in the office	e of the City Clerk.
