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Development Code Streamlining

- First step in larger strategic goal of a unified development code
- Renames Title 2 from "Buildings" to "Buildings and Development Code"
 - Building
 - Site development
 - Right-of-way
- Simplify and streamline development regulation



••• Administrative Authority Enhanceme

Public Notifications:

· Provides enhanced authority to require additional public notice

Project Meetings:

• Provides PDS Director with authority to require the developer/contractor to attend project specific meetings

Construction Nuisances:

Ability to develop relevant construction standards for nuisances in an equitable way



OTHER CODE CHANGES



Technical:

 City staff reviewed various development codes to identify and address technical, standards, or process changes.

Administrative:

 City staff have recommend various administrative changes to provide the Director with additional flexibility.

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EVALUATION/OUTREACH



Current Outreach:

- Code provides the authority for Director to established future rules
- Future rules will be developed using typical outreach model
