Subject: Fiscal Impact of Local 6 Police I.U.P.A. 2020 Extension and Modification to current Collective

Bargaining Agreement

Overview

The following provides an estimated fiscal impact of an agreement between the City of Tacoma and the Tacoma Police Local 6 I.U.P.A. bargaining extending the terms of the 2017-2019 Collective Bargaining Agreement through December 31, 2020, with modifications.

Fiscal Impact

Retroactive to January 1, 2020, wages shall be increased by four percent (4%).

The Local 6 proposal would contractually increase the local 26 and PPSMA wages:

Fund/Department	2020 FTE	2020 Proposed Incremental Expense
General Fund	23.0	\$325,000
Other General Government Funds	3.0	41,000
Total	26.0	\$366,000

The cost of this wage adjustment is available in the 2019-2020 Adopted Budget.
