SUMMARY AND PURPOSE:

A resolution authorizing the execution of a Letter of Agreement as negotiated with the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 483, Tacoma Power Unit.

BACKGROUND:

The resolution will authorize the execution of a Letter of Agreement negotiated with the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 483, Tacoma Power Unit.

The agreement provides for changes to language regarding the step progression for the classification of Telecommunications Utility Worker (CSC 5516). It provides that employees must successfully complete specific training outlined in the agreement in order to advance beyond Step 3 of the pay scale.

The Parties previously reached agreement on the transition of impacted classifications from the IBEW, Local 483, Click! Unit to the IBEW, Local 483, Tacoma Power unit, in a Letter of Agreement adopted by Resolution 40555, on February 18, 2020.

That Letter of Agreement retained Section 17.4 of the IBEW, Local 483, Click! Unit agreement, but inadvertently omitted previous language from Section 21.5.b of the agreement, leading to potential confusion about the step progression for employees in the Telecommunications Utility Worker classification. The letter provides language intended to clarify the step progression for the classification.

The agreement has been reached with the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 483, Tacoma Power Unit, and has been bargained in good faith.
