Accompanying this letter, please find Advisory Survey Number 8634 to install an 8-inch wastewater main in East 48th Street from East 'D' Street to East 'C' Street, thence north in East 'C' Street approximately 360 feet. The assessment rates have been established to reflect benefits to properties resulting from the proposed improvement.

Property owners may elect to have additional work performed during construction, i.e. side sewer laterals and have those costs added to their wastewater main assessment. The final costs for the additional work will be based on the contractor's unit prices, and actual quantities of material used. The estimated cost to extend the 8-inch wastewater main as noted in Advisory Survey 8634 is \$278,961.38.

To assist you in your survey efforts we have provided a list of property owners, addresses and estimated parcel assessments. The costs reflect the benefit to each parcel, and will expire on June 3, 2020.

Per City policies, Environmental Services Wastewater Utility will be contributing \$161,837.83, reducing the cost of the wastewater main extension; the balance will be assessed to the owners within the proposed Local Improvement District. If property owners representing 50% of the \$117,123.55 estimated assessments sign advisory survey 8634 the City will request the City Council to schedule a formation hearing for the neighborhoods consideration. The final assessments will be based on the actual quantities used at the contractor's unit prices.

E. 'C' STREET - WASTEWATER MAIN EXTENSION

Why isn't there a main in East 'C' Street?

- Wastewater mains are extended at the request of a neighborhood through a Local Improvement District or by an owner self-financing the extension through a Private Work Order.
 - Local Improvement District Requires a majority support of the abutting property owners being assessed for the cost of the main. The Local Improvement District provides public financing allowing owners to finance their assessment over time. Owners are responsible for a portion of the total cost of the design, inspection and construction. Properties within the assessment district are credited for the extension of the wastewater system. Parcels are noted on the City records.
 - A Private Work Order The owner hires a private engineer, who submits a set of plans to the Site Development group for review, once the plans are approved the owner hires a contractor to construct the main. The City oversees the construction of the main. The owner is responsible for 100% of the engineering, plan review, inspection and construction costs. The contributing properties are credited with the wastewater main extension and are noted on the City records.

Why must we reimburse the City for the construction of the wastewater main?

- Each parcel is responsible for the extension of the public wastewater main, either through the formation of a Local Improvement District or through a Work Order. If the extension is through a Local Improvement District the assessment are able to be financed. The City issues a Consolidated Local Improvement District Bonds on the tax free bond market allowing the bonds to be repaid through annual assessments from the parcels within the district. For extensions constructed through a work order the owners are responsible for 100% of the cost associated with the design, review and construction of the improvement. Public financing is not available for the Private Work Order option.
- The Tacoma Municipal Code, specifically section 12.08.350 provides guidance regarding how to credit parcels that have been responsible for their proportionate share of the main extension and how LID costs and In-Lieu-of-Assessments are to be calculated.

With the main being installed will my utility bill increase?

o If your property is within 200 feet of an existing main your utility bill reflects a wastewater item weather your property is connected to the main or not. If the main becomes available and is within 200 feet of your property, future utility bills will include a line item for wastewater weather your property is connected to the main or not. The charges are based on your winter month's water consumption. The charges are to treat the sewage that your property contributes to or would have contributed to the system and billing also allocates funding to maintain the system your neighborhood main is connecting to.

By how much?

• A typical monthly bill is approximately \$50.00 per month. The amount is based on your water consumption in the winter months.

What must I do?

- Are you supportive of a Local Improvement District that would provide financing of the main for 20 years? If so, we ask that you sign advisory survey No. 8634.
 The policy governing LIDs requires majority support from the properties within the proposed district.
- o If you're not supportive of a Local Improvement District don't sign advisory survey No. 8634. Upon sale of the property, the title report will list either your property as either included within the assessment district of an LID or is subject to an In-Lieu-of-Assessment. LID assessments are transferrable from owner to owner, since the assessment is against the property. If connected to the main, and the property has not paid its proportionate share of the main, the title report will note that the property is subject to an In-Lieu-of-Assessment. Mortgage companies typically require that the In-Lieu-of-Assessment be paid, so that the cloud is removed from the title report.

PROGRAMS

Septic System Amnesty Program

The program is administered by the Environmental Services Department, and provides an incentive to connect to the waste water main within two years of the main becoming available. The program would reduce either the base In-Lieu-of-Assessment or base Local Improvement District assessment by 50%. (TMC 12.08.350.F included). Sewer Conservation Loan Program

The program is administered by the Community & Economic Development
 Department and provides low interest loans to owners within the City of Tacoma for 10 years. Eligible expenses may include decommissioning of the on-site

disposal system and connection to the waste water lateral. (Program overview included). For additional information please contact Carol Hassard at 253-591-5645.

LID Assistance

O The program is administered by the Community & Economic Development Department and pays 100% of the base LID assessment for low or fixed income property owners who live on the property being included within the boundaries of a Local Improvement District; the program does not cover the cost of the wastewater lateral. Septic/Pump Tank Decommissioning Guide



Decommissioning Purpose

To ensure on-site sewage systems are properly abandoned to minimize potential health and safety hazards.

Decommissioning Regulations

Washington State Department of Health Rules and Regulations WAC 246-272A and Tacoma-Pierce County Board of Health Resolution 2014-4414:

Persons permanently removing a septic tank, sewage pit, cesspool, or other container from service shall:

- 1. Have the septage removed by an approved O&M Firm approved for pumping.
- 2. Remove or destroy the lid(s).
- 3. Remove the tank or fill the void space of the tank with soil or gravel.
- 4. Submit the Decommissioning Certificate form to the Tacoma-Pierce County Health Department.

To connect to public sewer or demolish a structure:

- 1. Complete plan review application (if required) with appropriate sewer utility and obtain a sewer application number (if applicable).
- Complete and submit the Health Department Septic/Pump Tank Decommissioning Certificate with appropriate fee.
- 3. Upon Health Department approval of decommissioning certificate, the Department will maintain a database record and provide electronic storage of the documents.

To abandon and replace a septic/pump tank:

- 1. Submit remodel/repair application for new system with appropriate fee.
- Complete Septic/Pump Tank Decommissioning Certificate (fee will be waived). Attach certificate to parent OSS application.

Submittal package must include all of the following:

- 1. Completed Septic/Pump Tank Decommissioning Certificate form signed by a licensed contractor.
- Application Fee.
- 3. Site Plan indicating location(s) of the decommissioned tank(s). Basic Site Plan requirements (Chapter 2, Section 28) apply.
- 4. Pumping receipt from Certified Installation or Pumping Company.
- 5. Sewer application number or Remodel/Repair application information.

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

Local Improvement District Advisory Survey number 8634 for the extension of an 8-inch diameter wastewater main in East 48th Street from the East 'D' Street to East 'C' Street, thence north on East 'C' Street approximately 360 feet is adequate. Tacoma City Council LID policy requires signatures from property owners representing 50% of the value of the estimated total assessments of the project, the LID office has calculated that the signatures on the advisory survey and reports that they represent 63% of the estimated total assessments.

Local Improvement Districts are created according to procedures set forth by state law and City Council policy. The next step of the process will be a public hearing scheduled with the concurrence of the City Council. Each property owner within the assessment district will be mailed a formation hearing notice indicating the date, time and place of the hearing, as well as their estimated assessment amount.










Local Improvement District 3971


