18 19	classification in which he or she was working on the date of separation to the extent of 25 percent of accrued sick leave hours.					
20	a. An employee separated from the City service due to retirement, and represented by the Tacoma					
21	Fire Fighters Union, Local 31, shall receive a contribution into the Washington State Council of Fire Fighters (WSCFF) Employee Benefit Trust a qualified Health Reimbursement Arrangement in					
22	the amount of the sick leave payment as defined in TMC Section 1.12.230.D.1 in lieu of a cash payment, when properly authorized annually by Local 31.					
23	b. An employee separated from service due to death or retirement for disability or length of service, and represented by the Tacoma Fire Fighters Union, Local 31, will be compensated for nonuse of					
24	sick leave accruals per the terms of the collective bargaining agreement.
