At approximately 4:39 p.m., Susan Haigh, Acting City Clerk, informed the Committee they will be interviewing 11 applicants for the Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority Board, four of which are seeking reappointment, and there are currently seven positions available on the Board, consisting of two At-Large positions, two attorney representatives, two contractor representatives, and one CPA representative. She further stated that the Committee may only choose to fill up to six of the positions, as no applicants qualify as a CPA representative; the incumbents are the only applicants eligible for the other four professional positions; and the additional seven applicants are eligible for the two At-Large positions.

The Committee interviewed Karsen Keever, Daniel Montopoli, Meredith Neal, Ian Northrip, Miriam McBride, Loreen "Lori" Keller, Noelle Kappert, Joseph "Joe" Van Dyk, and Michael Williams.

Ms. Haigh stated Michele Worthy withdrew her application from consideration and April Ferguson was unable to attend.
