

RESOLUTION NO. 40793

BY REQUEST OF MAYOR WOODARDS, DEPUTY MAYOR BLOCKER, AND COUNCIL MEMBER WALKER

A RESOLUTION authorizing the one-time use of up to \$10,000, budgeted from the Council Contingency Fund, for expenditures related to the 2021 Tacoma Reads Together programming and events.

WHEREAS "Tacoma Reads" is a local community reads program where the larger community is encouraged to read, think, and discuss compelling and meaningful themes from a selected book, and

WHEREAS the City works with the Tacoma Public Library to select titles for adult, young adult, children, and their families around a shared theme; develop programming; and arrange for a Tacoma event with the author of the adult selection, and

WHEREAS, in alignment with Resolution No. 40622, the 2021 Tacoma

Reads program will engage the community in conversations and programming that

explore the topics of race, social justice, and healing, and

WHEREAS, in partnership with the Tacoma Urban League as the primary event sponsor, the following titles have been selected for the 2021 Tacoma Reads Program:

- The children's selection is "The Day You Begin," by Jacqueline Woodson;
- The young adults selection is "A Good Kind of Trouble," by Lisa Moore Ramee; and
- The adult selection is "Caste," by Isabel Wilkerson, and

 WHEREAS, through "Caste," Pulitzer Prize-winning author Isabel Wilkerson

 gives us a masterful portrait of an unseen phenomenon in America as she



explores, through an immersive, deeply researched narrative and stories about real people, how America today and throughout its history has been shaped by a hidden caste system, a rigid hierarchy of human rankings, and

WHEREAS the 2021 Tacoma Reads programming will include a virtual event with Isabel Wilkerson which is tailored to the Tacoma community, and

WHEREAS Mayor Woodards, Deputy Mayor Blocker, and Council Member Walker have shared a Council Consideration Request to authorize the one-time use of \$10,000, budgeted from the Council Contingency Fund, to support the 2021 Tacoma Reads programming and events, and

WHEREAS the Tacoma Urban League is providing a sponsorship of \$25,000 to expand on the programming for this year's titles, and this would mark the third year that the City Council has provided a \$10,000 sponsorship of the Tacoma Reads program, and

WHEREAS RCW 35.34.250 and 35.34.260 authorize a withdrawal from the Council Contingency fund for any municipal expense, the necessity or extent of which could not have been foreseen or reasonably evaluated at the time of adopting the budget, and

WHEREAS Ordinance No. 22569 requires an affirmative vote of not less than six members of the Council in order to withdraw moneys from this fund; Now, Therefore,



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:
