1. <u>21-0285</u>	South Tacoma Groundwater Protection District and Underground Storage Tanks Update [Lisa Spadoni, Principal Planner, Planning and Development Services; Glenn Rollins, Environmental Health Specialist Supervisor; Rob Olsen, Environmental Health Specialist III, Tacoma-Pierce County Health Department]
	At approximately 4:33 p.m., Lisa Spadoni, Principal Planner, Planning and Development Services (PDS), introduced Glenn Rollins, Environmental Health Specialist Supervisor, and Rob Olsen, Environmental Health Specialist III, Tacoma-Pierce County Health Department (TPCHD). Together they presented the South Tacoma Groundwater Protection District (STGPD) and underground storage tank (UST) site cleanup program, including an overview, background of the STGPD, agency roles, zoning and land use, permitted facilities, permitting and inspections, infiltration system permitting, the UST program, completed cleanups, contaminated UST sites, surveillance of diesel and gas plumes, and cleanup accountability.
	Discussion ensued regarding land use and contamination, ways to encourage cleanup efforts, Tacoma Water testing regulations, impacts on economic development, and cleanup assistance for property owners.

# 2. 21-0286 Solid Waste Management Recycle Reset Update [Lewis Griffith, Solid Waste Management Division]

At approximately 5:18 p.m., Lewis Griffith, Solid Waste Division Manager, and Preston Peck, Project Specialist, Environmental Services, presented the update on the Recycle Reset project, including background, 2020 recycling markets, market trends, glass transition, glass drop-off sites, tons collected, transcreation update, Recycle Reset project budget, and the timeline on project completion.

Discussion ensued regarding Americans with Disabilities Act compliance for drop-off sites, promoting site use through education and outreach, public feedback, site maintenance, adjusting site pickup based on use, submitting broken glass, information in multiple languages, customer feedback, and customer demographics and site use statistics.
