















Short Term Strategy



Datrol

- · Special Emphasis Team Missions
- High Patrol visibility in identified Hot Spot areas
- · Track emphasis efforts

Investigations

- Reallocation of 5 detectives and sergeant to be fully trained and dedicated to the apprehension of persons responsible for violent crimes, separate from and in addition to the current Homicide Unit
- Utilize and connect investigative resources with long term designated/assigned Prosecutor's within Prosecutor's Office
- Re-direct Special Investigations (SI) missions to be an integral force multiplier

Community Policing

- Community Engagement with residents and businesses in Hot Spot areas
- Partner with service providers and community groups to reduce youth violence

Administrative Services

- Request HR analysis of comparable law enforcement agencies
- Partner with Human Resources to reduce hiring process time
 - Goal to reduce recruiting/hiring process to 120 days
- Request for new and lateral officer incentive program
- Utilize analytics for continual assessment and accountability

Mid Term Strategy



- Develop and pursue intelligence-based leads pursuant to patterns of groups repeatedly involved in gun violence
- Enhance regional partnerships in sharing intelligence-based leads thereby increasing efficiency in apprehending mobile offenders throughout the entire Puget Sound
- Partnerships with long term assigned Prosecutors is refined, increasing efficiency in criminal charges
- Ongoing collaboration with City of Tacoma Human Resources
- Implement online testing platform, increasing to five tests annually
- · Develop recruitment program


Long Term Strategy




- Divertible calls for service full implementation

- Assess Crime Analysis Unit data systems and increase capacity with technology and staffing








- 2020 BLEA conducted 18 academy classes
 - Tacoma Police entered recruits into six academy classes
 - 27 recruit officers
 - 4 lateral officers
- 2021 BLEA conducted 16 academy classes
 - 2 recruit officers
 - 5 recruit officers currently enrolled
 - 3 recruit officers anticipated enrollment in November
