

OF SIGNIFICANCE & ••• EIS OVERVIEW SCOPING NOTICE CONDUCT SEPA SCOPING Provides involvement for the public, other agencies, and tribes to participate in developing and analyzing information. Improves proposals from an environmental perspective [WAC 197-11-400(4)]. DRAFT EIS PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD Provides decision-makers with environmental information. PREPARE FINAL EIS Environmental impacts considered area-wide, ISSUE FINAL EIS earlier in planning process. CITY ACTION



SCOPE OF INTERIM ORDINANCE

Four issue areas were addressed:

- 1. Permit and Land Use Notifications
- 2. Conversion of Industrial Lands
- 3. Residential Encroachment
- 4. Siting of Heavy Industrial Uses

*******BACKGROUND



- Interim Ordinance passed in November 2017;
 - Extended six times
- Amended Ordinance No. 28696, extending the Interim Ordinance, directed the Planning Commission to consider a "Non-Interim" recommendation;
- Following a Public Hearing on April 27, 2021, the City Council referred the proposed ordinance to the IPS Committee;
- IPS Committee concluded review and finalized recommendations on August 30, 2021;
- Public Hearing scheduled for October 5, 2021.

PROCESS IPS COMMITTEE PROCESS



- Conducted 9 meetings between May 26 and August 30, 2021;
- Accepted written comments on agenda materials;
- Meetings included opportunities for stakeholder presentations and discussion with the Committee, including:
 - Business and industry representatives
 - Environmental organizations
 - Affected property owners
 - Puget Sound Clean Air Agency
 - Port of Tacoma
 - South Sound Military and Communities Partnership
