1. Call to Order; Roll Call

Tacoma Creates Program Manager Lisa Jaret called the TCAB meeting to order at 5:40pm.

2. Warm-up / Check-ins

Lisa Jaret facilitated the meeting check-in, which was to share how folks are feeling overall with school starting.

3. Public Comment

Lisa Jaret provided space for attendees to share public comment. There were no public comments made at this time.

4. Program Updates

Clarissa Gines shared updates about organization reporting – funded organizations have now completed the first quarter of programming, and have reports and summer invoices can be submitted to staff. She also shared information on Beyond the Bell – the branding of after school programs happening in the Tacoma Public Schools.

Lisa Jaret updated everyone on TCAB transitions, and shared that four individuals have been interviewed, and recommended by the Economic Development Committee (EDC) to be appointed to TCAB; these recommendations are scheduled to go to City Council on October 12. She also provided information on the Tacoma Creates Annual Report, specifically sharing a budget chart that will be included in this report, which illustrates the financial picture of Tacoma Creates.

5. TCAB Engagement/Operations

A timeline was shared around TCAB Leadership positions. Lisa informed TCAB members that TCAB leadership nominations will be accepted in November, with voting in December, and the newly appointed Leadership team starting their term in January 2022.

Lisa also shared an update from the Annual Report committee, and Liesl Santkuyl shared reported on work done by the Application Guidelines & Review Criteria committee.

Lisa Jaret introduced Julia Berg, Director of Education & Community Engagement at Foss Waterway Seaport; Nora Flemming de Sandoval, Education Manager at LeMay – America's Car Museum; and Tony Gomez, Associate Director of Education at Tacoma Arts Live before they all presented about the education work their organizations provide, and how Tacoma Creates funding has supported this work.

Lisa then facilitated questions at the end of the presentations. There was lots of engagement and appreciation shared from TCAB members.

7. OACV Staff Reports

Naomi Strom-Avila shared information about the Tacoma Arts Commission's 2022 Community Arts Projects funding application which is now available. She also mentioned that the Tacoma Arts Commission is currently seeking individuals to serve on their commission. Lastly, Naomi provided information on Tacoma Arts Month, including a call for individuals to volunteer at Arts at the Armory.

8. Closing Comments

TCAB Members

Lisa Jaret provided space for TCAB members to share any suggestions for future agenda items, and any engagement with Tacoma Creates-funded programming. Roxane Hreha asked if there are ways that schools can request specific in-school and after school programming, which Lisa Jaret addressed.
