RESOLUTION NO. 40852

A RESOLUTION relating to the Biennial Budget; setting Tuesday, November 9, 1 2021, upon completion of Regular Agenda Items, no earlier than 5:15 p.m., 2 as the date for a public hearing by the City Council on the proposed modifications to the 2021-2022 Biennial Operating Budget, 2021-2022 3 Capital Budget, and the 2021-2026 Capital Facilities Program. 4 WHEREAS RCW 35.34.100 provides that, following the filing of the 5 preliminary budget with the City Clerk, the Clerk shall publish a notice once a week, 6 7 for two consecutive weeks, stating that the preliminary budget for the ensuing fiscal 8 biennium has been filed with the Clerk; designating the date, time, and place of the 9 legislative budget meeting; and that any taxpayer may appear and be heard for or 10 against the budget, and 11 WHEREAS RCW 35.34.110 provides that a city's legislative body shall meet 12 13 on or before the first Monday of the month next preceding the beginning of the 14 ensuing fiscal biennium for the purpose of fixing the final budget of the city at the 15 time and place designated in the notice thereof, and 16 WHEREAS, additionally, proposed amendments to the Comprehensive Plan 17 are considered annually by the Planning Commission and City Council, and, with 18 19 few exceptions, RCW 36.70A.130(2)(a) requires that all proposed Plan amendments 20 be reviewed concurrently and no more frequently than once per year, and 21 WHEREAS state law provides an exception for an amendment to the Capital 22 Facilities Element of the Comprehensive Plan, which may be adopted separately 23 from other amendments to the Comprehensive Plan if adoption occurs concurrently 24 25 with the adoption or amendment of the City's budget; Now, Therefore, 26

6	Capital Budget, and the 2021-2026 Capital Facilities Program, shall commence on
7	Tuesday, November 9, 2021, upon completion of the Regular Agenda items, no
8	earlier than 5:15 p.m., in the City Council Chambers, First Floor, Tacoma Municipal
9	Building, 747 Market Street, Tacoma, Washington, unless the Governor's
10	proclamation or the City's rule limiting in-person meetings is still in effect and then a
11	
12	call in option will be provided.
13	Section 2. That the City Clerk shall give proper notice of the time and place
14	of said hearing.
