## **Briefing Items**

#### 1. <u>17-0345</u> Washington State Legislative Updates

At approximately 12:10 p.m., Randall Lewis, Government Relations Officer, presented legislative updates related to the status of City bills of interest, including House Bill (HB) 1495, which provides a local tax incentive for commercial office space; HB 1570 and Senate Bill (SB) 5254, which create a permanent document recording fee surcharge, and increases the fee to \$90; HB 1298 and SB 5312, requiring statewide implementation of ban-the-box; HB 1201, concerning the taxing authority of public facilities districts; and HB 1594 and HB 1595, related to amendments to the Public Records Act.

Council Member Ibsen arrived here, at 12:19 p.m.

Mr. Lewis concluded by providing a budget comparison, and discussing upcoming dates in the legislature.

Discussion ensued regarding the Housing Trust Fund.
