2. <u>19-0650</u> City Events and Recognitions Committee Interviews [Doris Sorum, City Clerk]

At approximately 10:03 a.m., Doris Sorum, City Clerk, informed the Committee they would be interviewing three applicants for the City Events and Recognitions Committee, including Rhonda Ware, who was unable to attend the May 14, 2019 interviews, where the Committee requested to interview her in person or by phone. She stated that Ms. Ware would be participating telephonically, as well as Glendon McCallum. Ms. Sorum concluded by stating that there are two positions open on the Committee, consisting of Council District Nos. 2 and 5.

The Committee interviewed Adan Espino, Rhonda Ware, and Glendon McCallum.

Discussion ensued regarding applicants' qualifications and familiarity of City events.

3. <u>19-0651</u> Commercial Office Space Development Incentive [Gloria Fletcher, Business Development Manager, Community and Economic Development]

> At approximately 10:36 a.m., Gloria Fletcher, Business Development Manager, Community and Economic Development, presented an overview of the commercial office space development and rehabilitation incentive, including background, project timeline, potential development areas, building quality definitions, property tax allocations, sales and use tax allocations, considerations, a project example, and proposed legislation. She concluded by reviewing the implementation process and recommendations.

Discussion ensued throughout regarding the allowed total assessed value percentage, jurisdictions, approval process, evaluations, infrastructure requirements, duration of the property tax allocations, impact fees, developer tax credit, parking, benefits, and the developers' involvement.
