Urban Forestry Management Plan

At approximately 4:36 p.m., Mike Carey, Urban Forest Program Manager, Office of Environmental Policy and Sustainability, intoduced Chris Peiffer, Director of Urban Forestry Consulting Services, PlanIT Geo, and together they presented the urban forestry management plan, including an overview; the six planning elements of phase one, noting existing policies and plans, city staff interviews, urban forest benchmarks, high-level and in-depth data analysis, community interests and input, and urban forest sustainability and management audit; and conclusions.

Discussion ensued throughout regarding reconciling greater density of population with tree canopy growth, pushback from developers, and next steps.
