1.	<u>21-0938</u>	"Brewery Blocks" Place Name Designation [Melanie Harding, Chief Policy Analyst to the Mayor, City Manager's Office] At approximately 4:33 p.m., Melanie Harding, Chief Policy Analyst to the Mayor, City Manager's Office, presented the place name designation request for the Brewery Blocks area, including background, location, the naming request application, community outreach done by the requestors, the naming request process, the Committee's recommendations options, and next steps.
		Discussion ensued regarding soliciting public comment and feedback, possible objections to the request, recommendations from staff, the Landmarks Preservation Commission, sending out a press release regarding the proposal, and next steps.

2. <u>21-0939</u> Home in Tacoma Review [Peter Huffman, Director; Brian Boudet, Division Manager, Planning and Development Services]

> At approximately 4:56 p.m., Peter Huffman, Director, and Brian Boudet, Planning Division Manager, Planning and Development Services, presented a review of the Home in Tacoma Project, including meeting objectives; scope and schedule; topics reviewed so far; the reasons behind the amount of space designated for mid-scale housing; recommended infill design policies; mid-scale examples; key themes of the Infrastructure, Planning, and Sustainability Committee's September 22, 2021, meeting map discussion; potential new criterion, noting principal arterials and nonconforming sites; phasing options; and next steps.

Discussion ensued throughout regarding site options, impacts to the surrounding neighborhoods, nonconforming sites, the different map options, density requirements, affordable housing, the Affordable Housing Action Plan, Multi-Family Tax Exemptions, creating a design review panel, working with the housing development community, what type of housing is expected, time frame for the current phases, the process to bring the topic to the Committee, and next steps.
