BY REQUEST OF MAYOR BAARSIVIA AND COUNCIL MEMBERS FEY, LADENBURG, AND WALKER

A RESOLUTION creating an Office of Sustainability and establishing the
Sustainable Tacoma Commission on Climate Change.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:
Section 1. That there is created an Office of Sustainability ("Office"),
which shall report to the City Manager and the duties of which shall include:
(1) Research and development of City policies and programs that foster
achievement of the City's sustainability goals and objectives; (2) Establishment
community and periodic updates and reports on the achievement of those goals, including financial savings to the City; (3) Provide staff support to the
actively support sustainable activities of government agencies in Pierce County.

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Section 2. That, pursuant to and consistent with the Tacoma City
